The next on-campus COVID-19 vaccination clinic is today, September 22, from 11:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. in the Rotunda of Cowles Hall.

Those who received their first dose of a two-dose vaccine at the September 1 clinic should get their second dose at today's clinic.

Those still needing to start and finish their vaccination requirement by the October 8 deadline can receive the one-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine today – no appointment needed.

Elmira College students from outside of New York State should use the College address (One Park Place, Elmira, NY 14901) when submitting forms. Students with questions should email the Clarke Health Center at clarkehealth@elmira.edu.

All students who are partially or fully vaccinated, as well as those with approved exemptions, are eligible from now until the vaccine deadline of October 8 to win a \$100 or \$50 Amazon Gift Card each week, as long as your documentation has been turned into the Clarke Health Center. Drawings will be held on Fridays, so students getting vaccinated today will be eligible for this week's drawing as long as a copy of your vaccine card is given to the CHC by the end of the day on Thursday.

All employees who are partially or fully vaccinated, as well as those with approved exemptions, are also eligible from now until the vaccine deadline of October 8 to win a variety of gift cards, as long as your documentation has been turned into the Human Resources Office. Drawings will be held on Fridays, so employees getting vaccinated today will be eligible for this week's drawing provided a copy of your vaccine card is given to HR by the end of the day on Thursday.
