Dear EC Community,

New York State Electric & Gas (NYSEG) informed us yesterday afternoon that they will be testing their electrical grid near campus on Friday, February 2. As a result, **campuswide electricity will be turned off between 6:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on Friday,** and **remain off until NYSEG completes their work, which could be one hour to all day.**

Therefore, all on-campus classes will be canceled and offices closed on Friday, 2/2. The Campus Center will not have power, but it will be open all day for students to gather. Emerson and GTL will reopen once the electricity is restored.

All off-campus classes, such as nursing clinicals, internships, practicums, and student teaching will take place.

Please keep in mind that the following will not be available/functioning on campus while the electricity is out:

- Lights
- Toilets
- Showers, sinks, and water fountains
- Campus Wireless
- EC Share Drives
- 1855 Room
- Dining Hall Limited *Grab* & *Go* options will be available in the Dining Hall for breakfast and lunch (if power isn't restored by then).

As soon as testing is complete and EC's electricity is back up, a text alert will be sent to the campus community. To ensure you're signed up for the alerts, <u>log into the alert system</u> and confirm that your information is correct. The log-in information for registration is your Elmira College email address and secure password.

Students: check email or Canvas announcements by Thursday for any course instructions from your faculty. Student-athletes should check with their coaches to see how this might affect practice or competition schedules.

Employees: check with your supervisor on how this affects your schedule.

This email and any updates will also be posted to the homepage of MyEC.

Thank you for your patience and understanding while we work through this NYSEG testing period.
