As we prepare to transition back to in-person classes, I wanted to share some clarifications and updates.

**We do not yet have an exact date for a return to in-person classes.** That date is dependent upon the number of COVID-19 cases falling below the 5% threshold and an approval from the Chemung County Health Department. At this point, the number of cases on campus are decreasing, but we continue to monitor the situation closely.

**Any students who left campus and are currently at home are expected to remain at home,** until further notice. Once the College confirms a date with the Health Department, students will receive specific instructions, including a link to sign up for a scheduled time to return to campus.
