This form is for you to use in applying for a medical exemption to Elmira College's COVID-19 vaccination requirements. Its purpose is to establish the medical basis for your request since the College permits exemptions on the basis of a medical condition/reason for not receiving vaccination.<sup>1</sup>

Students requesting a medical exemption must submit a written and signed statement from the student's personal care physician (PCP) or other licensed health care professional who has established a provider/patient relationship with the student, which states the basis on which vaccination would be harmful to the student or is otherwise medically contraindicated.

In the area provided below, please have your PCP or other treating practitioner write the statement. The statement must address all of the following elements:

- Explain why the request for the medical exemption is being made.
- Indicate the student's health condition which is a valid contraindication to receiving indicated vaccine(s), and the basis for concluding that the vaccine(s) is/are contraindicated.
- Specify those vaccinations which may be detrimental and the length of time they may be detrimental.

Additional written pages or other supporting materials may be attached to this form, if you so choose.

I certify that I have an established professional provider/patient relationship with the student named above, and that he/she/they has/have the above contraindication, and request a medical exemption for Elmira College's vaccination requirement(s)
