Dear Students,

As we prepare for your return to campus for the Winter 2021 Term, I wanted to send out a quick message to clarify the requirements for those who have previously tested positive for the coronavirus.

If you tested positive for COVID-19 more than 90 days ago (on or before **October 11, 2020**), you **WILL NEED TO BE TESTED AGAIN** prior to arrival to campus.

If you tested positive after **October 11, 2020**, you do **NOT** need to test prior to arrival at school. In addition, if you were positive after October 11, 2020, you will **NOT** need to quarantine upon return to campus.

It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that you upload any and all test results to your student health portal. If we do not have proof of when you were tested and the results, you **WILL NOT** be permitted to return to campus.

If you have not completed the form that was sent by Residence Life regarding return to campus plans, please do so immediately.
