Dear Residential Students,

As President Lindsay announced earlier this afternoon, we are partnering with Cayuga Medical to do SARS-CoV-2 testing on campus tomorrow, October 1. Appointments are required. The testing will follow Cayuga Medical's protocol for the collection of saliva samples. Please read the following information carefully.

Test Details

Date: Thursday, October 1, 2020

Time: Students will register for a time from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. or 1:00-4:00 p.m.

Location: Speidel Gymnasium

Who: All Residential Students currently on campus and not currently in isolation. Students currently in quarantine on campus or the Holiday Inn will be tested, but those tests will be delivered directly to those students. Quarantining students should not leave their rooms.

Cost: The cost of this test is covered by the College, if not covered by your current insurance.

You must arrive promptly at your scheduled time (not early or late). There is a very specific schedule and time frame to help prevent gatherings. Face coverings must be worn and everyone must stay 6' apart, especially at the registration table.

Once you register, you will receive a confirmation number. Tomorrow, when you go for your test, you should give the check-in staff that confirmation number.

Quarantining students: you must register but skip the schedule section.

Each individual tested will have access to a dashboard with their information and test results. Test results should be available within 24 hours.
