I hope that this message finds you and your families safe and healthy. As a follow-up to the message sent on Wednesday, December 16, 2020, from President Lindsay, I wanted to send out additional updates and guidance as we prepare for the Winter 2021 term.

All Commuter and Part-Time Students:

1) **Commuter, part-time, and graduate students will schedule an on-campus test time within one week of the start of in-person classes.**

Students who do not report for testing **when scheduled** will need to have a negative test result uploaded to the student portal within five days of the start of classes. Test results should be uploaded into the student health portal <https://elmira.studenthealthportal.com/> (Use your EC username and password to log in, go to the "document upload" tab, browse documents and upload to the portal). Students will receive confirmation from the Clarke Health Center that their results have been received.

2) For students who have had a positive COVID test result within the last ninety days, Chemung County Health Department has advised that you do NOT need to retest. If it has been greater than ninety days, you will need to retest and submit your results to the Clarke Health Center. Specific questions regarding this can be directed to the Clarke Health Center at clarkehealth@elmira.edu.
