Dear Students,

We hope you have all enjoyed your February winter break and we are looking forward to your return to campus! As you prepare for your arrival on campus, we would like to update you all about the check-in procedure.

As you are all aware, **residential students who leave campus for the break will be required to get a COVID test within 72 hours** of your return to campus. Please remember, you **MUST upload a copy of the test result to the student health portal**, <https://elmira.studenthealthportal.com> **PRIOR to your arrival on campus.**

If you have had COVID and:

- you tested positive more than 90 days prior to your return to campus, you will need to be tested again; OR
- you tested positive within the 90 days leading up to your return to campus, you do NOT need to test prior to arrival, however, you must upload your dated test results

As a reminder, home tests **will not** be accepted, and the Clarke Health Center **will not** be providing testing the weekend prior to classes resuming.

Check in will be Sunday, February 27 from 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. in the Campus Center at the Information Desk.

If you were **approved to stay** on campus over break, you **do not** need to provide a COVID test, and are **not required** to check in on Sunday, February 27.

If you **went home for break**, but upload a COVID test result prior to returning to campus on Sunday, you are **not required** to check in. You will receive an email by Saturday evening, stating you are cleared to return to campus on Sunday, February 27.

If you **went home for break**, but **do not upload** a COVID test prior to Sunday, you will be **required** to come to the Campus Center between 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. on Sunday to show your negative test result to a residence life staff member. Once you have been cleared, residence life staff will grant you access to enter your building.

If you have not uploaded your COVID test result, have not been cleared by the Clarke Health Center, or come to check in on Sunday, February 27, you will not be allowed into your residence hall.

Please keep an eye on your email on Saturday, February 26 and Sunday February 27, stating if you are cleared to return and if you must check in.
